


# ARGUMENT ESSAY ESSENTIALS

Intro: CLAIM - The last sentence of your intro that states what your **WHOLE** essay argues to prove.

Body P's  
#1 and 2

- ① Argument that supports claim
- ② Evidence - (LOGOS only!) that supports the argument
- ③ Explain what evidence proves
- ④ So what? Explain what the evidence & explanation show about the claim and why it's important

Body #3



Conclusion: Re-state your claim, and why your arguments are valid/make sense

# MLK's LETTER YOUR PAPER

## Persuasive

- uses personal thoughts, feelings, and opinions to get point across
- can use emotions to get point across
- attempts to persuade the reader to change his/her mind or view and agree with the author
- does not present opposing view

## Argumentative

- presents one side of an issue to the reader using facts, data, and research
  - must analyze informational text to generate a thesis statement / claim
  - must analyze informational text to address the counterclaim and prove it wrong
- Just the Facts, Please!**
- LOGOS only!**
