
Metacognition—Thinking about one's own thinking

META=a prefix added to the name of something that consciously references or comments upon its own subject

COGNTION=the act or process of knowing; perception

Metacognition: Reading is Thinking (p.2-3 of Comprehension Connections)

- Using Schema: Thoughtful readers make connections, and retrieve and activate prior knowledge.
 - o This reminds me of...
 - o I'm remembering...
 - o I'm connecting this to..
 - o I can relate to...
- Inferring: Thoughtful readers draw conclusions, make predictions, and form interpretations.



- Questioning: Thoughtful readers generate questions before, during, and after reading.
- Determining Importance: Thoughtful readers sift out relevant and useful information.
- Visualizing: Thoughtful readers create mental images supported by the five senses.
- Synthesizing: Thoughtful readers continually change their thinking in response to a text. Thoughtful readers can form ideas by combining parts or elements.
