

Annotating a Text—Metacognition Style

- A. ?—Put a question mark by anything that is confusing or generates a question or wonder of your own. Write the question(s) in the margin of the page.
- B. Draw me a picture/image about something that stuck with you in the blank section below.
- C. S—Put an S (for schema) next to any detail/evidence that helps you to think about what you already know.
- D. *—Put a star (*) by 2-4 important details or ideas. Be prepared to explain why you chose these.
- E. Somewhere in the margins, write down 2-4 inferences you have made based on your schema and evidence in the text. Put a big I next to them. Be prepared to explain.
- F. Write a one-sentence summary of the chapter (excerpt) OR title the chapter (excerpt)
