

Hunger Games Discussion Board Assignment

Discussion Board Post due on Thursdays (January 14, 21, 28)

Each week, you will get on SCHOOLGY and post to the Hunger Games Discussion Board. There are several different questions/threads posted on the Discussion Board. Your job is to respond to **one** question by Thursday.

Here are some tips:

- Type your response in a Google Doc **first**, then copy and paste it to Schoology. This way, if something goes wrong with your internet/Schoology connection, all your writing isn't lost.
- Write in **complete sentences** and watch your capitalization, grammar, and sentence structure because that's what good writers do.
- There are no "right" answers to these questions. However, **you should still refer back to the text** in order to support your thoughts.
- Each response should be **multiple paragraphs**. This means AT LEAST 2 paragraphs.

Directions:

- Go to Schoology and read through all of the of the HUNGER GAMES posts for that week
 - Notice that each week has several different posts
- Reply to ONE post for each WEEK.
 - Each week there will be several different discussion boards to pick from. Your job is to pick ONE. Also, before responding, make sure you pick the correction week/part. (Week 1 goes with Part 1 of the book, etc.)
- Put your post in the area that says "Write a Comment"
- Push POST

Peer Response "Post" due on Tuesdays (January 19, 26 and February 2)

This is supposed to be an online discussion. This means that after you post each week's discussion board post, you will need to respond to a peer (just like you would in a real discussion). These responses need to be directly related to what your peer had originally typed.

Here are some tips:

- You can pose a **question**, make a **connection** based on your schema, or **agree/disagree** and explain yourself.
- Each response should be at least **ONE** paragraph.
- Write in **complete sentences** and watch your capitalization, grammar, and sentence structure because that's what good writers do.
- Be **respectful** and **thoughtful** in your answers, just like you would if you were having a face-to-face conversation

Directions:

- Go to the **Hunger Games Discussion Posts on Schoology** and read through your peer's posts
- Find one that you find specifically interesting and respond to it by clicking "Reply" (directly under the response)
- When you're done, click "Post Reply"

Each week you must pick a **different person** to respond to.
Try to find a response that has not been replied to yet!

Grading:

Discussion Board Post: 10 points per week	Peer Response Post: 5 points per week
