Façade (n)

• An outward appearance that is maintained/shown to hide a less pleasant reality or truth

Treason (n)

- The offense of acting to overthrow one's government or to harm or kill its ruler
- A violation of allegiance to one's country or ruler

Perception (n)

• A way of regarding, interpreting, or understanding something based on your senses.

Dystopia (n)

• An imagined place or state in which everything is unpleasant or bad, typically because of environment or totalitarian government.

Reap (v)

• To receive as an award or benefit, based on one's individual actions.

Utopian (adj)

 Modeled for an imagined state in which everything is perfect

Ambiguous (adj)

• Unclear due to a double meaning or open to more than one interpretation.

Cornucopia (n)

• A symbol of plenty consisting of a goat's horn overflowing with fruits, vegetables, and flowers
