Rapport (n)



- A close and harmonious relationship in which the people or groups communicate and understand each other well.

Poise (n)



- Graceful, calm, and/or elegant in your appearance and/or composure

Revoke (v)



- To put an end to the validity of something
- To cancel officially

Attribute (n)



- A usually good quality or feature of a person or thing

Palpable (adj)



- Able to be touched or felt; tangible
- A feeling or atmosphere so intense as to ALMOST be touched or felt.

Ex: A palpable sense of loss

Arduous (adj)



- Very challenging, difficult, or strenuous; requiring a great deal of effort

Ominous (adj)



- Threatening or foreshadowing something evil or tragic development

Contrived (adj)



- Carefully created or planned rather than arising naturally or spontaneously
- Created in a way that seems unrealistic or artificial
